

## DEVELOPMENT OF REGULATIONS

The Board delegates to the Superintendent the function of specifying required actions and designing the regulations and detailed arrangements under which the schools operate. They must be consistent with the policies adopted by the Board and communicated to the Board.

The Board itself formulates and adopts regulations only when required by law, or when the Superintendent recommends Board adoption in light of strong community attitudes and/or potential staff reaction.

The Superintendent will formulate regulations consistent with current Board policy, when necessary. The regulation will not require Board adoption unless it is required by law, or there is disagreement among two or more Board members regarding the content of the regulation.
