

INTRADISTRICT OPEN ENROLLMENT

The Milford Exempted Village Board of Education believes that students should attend the school building of residency. However, the Board acknowledges that intradistrict enrollment may occur.

As such the Board will permit students to apply for attendance at their school of choice based upon criteria established by the school administration. Enrollment decisions are made on an annual basis and subject to the availability of room in the building each year, with preference given to those students living within the attendance area first. Approval of intradistrict enrollment is granted for one year only. Students are required to apply annually for intradistrict enrollment. The specific criteria shall be consistent with Ohio Revised Code Sections (RC) 3313.64 or 3313.65 and shall include:

1. application procedures, including deadlines for application and for notification of students and principals of alternative schools whenever a student's application is accepted. Only students wishing to attend another school need apply.
2. procedures for admitting applicants to other schools including but not limited to:
 - A. establishing District capacity limits by grade level, school building and educational program;
 - B. requiring students enrolled in a school building or living in the attendance area of the school building established by the Superintendent or Board by giving preference over applicants and
 - C. ensuring that an appropriate racial balance is maintained in the District schools.
